Register now for biodiesel fuel seminars

URBANDALE, Iowa—A series of biodiesel fuel management seminars are planned across Iowa in September. The seminars will offer the best management practices of blending, storing and using biodiesel year-round, including cold weather use.

The biodiesel fuel management seminars will also cover biodiesel use in 2007 engines and Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel. The seminars will be held on the following dates and locations:
